CLASS PARTICIPANTS

- Wisdom Project participants should be adults age 55 and wiser who have volunteer or leadership experience.
- As a commitment to the group, attendance at the monthly meetings is mandatory unless an emergency arises.
- Only two absences are allowed for a successful graduation. Graduates of the program may serve on the Wisdom Keeper's Council – an advisory group for subsequent programs and advocacy projects.
- A maximum of 60 participants are selected annually.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Based on the submitted application information, class members are chosen by The Wisdom Project Selection Committee. The committee seeks representation from a cross-section of the Greater Hall County community. It is anticipated that there will be more applications than openings. If not accepted, applicants are encouraged to apply the next session for enrollment. Couples are invited to apply. Please submit one (1) application per person.

LOCATION

Classes are held at various locations throughout the county. Some of the classes will be held at Brenau University's Gainesville historic campus. Tours and site visits to various locations in Gainesville – Hall County comprise a portion of the program curriculum.

TUITION

A tuition fee is required to cover materials, monthly program expenses and administration. Cost of the program is \$175 per person. Please do not send payment with this application. Tuition is non-refundable. If you must cancel due to health reasons, tuition may be transferable to a future session.

COMMITMENT

- Each participant will be expected to attend seven sessions, plus the kickoff event and graduation ceremony.
- Generally, the class meets on the second and fourth Friday of the month from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., including a 30-minute lunch period. Your schedule will need to be planned accordingly.
- The last session is a full day, including project presentations, graduation and a graduation reception.
