CPR	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> MUST be BLS (Basic Life Saver) certification (CPR & AED) American Heart Association is the preferred provider 	2 years
Background Check & Drug Screen	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Must complete through Advantage Students You may be required to obtain additional checks for future fieldwork 	One-time
Physical Exam	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You may receive a free physical at the Brenau Center for Health and Wellbeing Any basic physical will suffice 	Yearly
PPD (TB) Test	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You may receive a TB test at the Brenau Center for Health and Wellbeing for a small fee If you test positive, a chest x-ray will be required 	Yearly
Hepatitis B	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You must have the 3 shot series OR a titer proving immunity 	One-time
Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You must have the 2 shot series OR a titer proving immunity 	One-time
Varicella (Chicken Pox)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You are required to upload a titer proving immunity OR 2 shot vaccination series Proof of disease is not accepted by many fieldwork sites, therefore a titer is recommended but not required 	One-time
Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Tdap is a 5 dose series obtained as a child. You will ALSO need to keep track of needed Td boosters that occur every 10 years 	As needed
Flu Shot	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> May be required during your time in the program NOT required for Brenau 	N/A
AOTA & GOTA Memberships	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Provides access to various resources throughout your time in the program 	Yearly
OSHA & HIPAA Training Modules	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You will receive login information to HIPAA Exams following orientation. You will then complete the following 4 modules: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> HIPAA For Health Care Workers OSHA Bloodborne Pathogens Training Aseptic Techniques Training Fire and Electrical Safety 	One-time
